

Examination guidelines: MNP2601 June 2018
SECOND OPPORTUNITY

- Date: **28 June 2018** (*It remains students' responsibility to verify the date, venue and time.*)
- **70 marks**
- **2 hours**
- Paper is **fill-in format**
- Some questions (from both sections) in the paper are based on a *case study*, which is provided before section A starts. *Take time to read the case study attentively.*
- **Section A (35 marks):** MCQ 21-35 are based on the case study and MCQ 1-20 are general theory questions. See your Tutorial Letter for examples of typical case study and theory MCQs.
- Make sure to make a **back-up of your answers to the MCQs** in your question paper by circling the number you have chosen.
- **Section B (35 marks):** **Questions 1 (10 marks) is compulsory**, where after you need to complete **any one** of the subsequent two questions (questions 2 and 3). **You will not receive any marks for answering both questions 2 and 3.** If you decide to answer both questions 2 and 3, only question 2 will be marked.
- Make sure to indicate which one of the two questions (from questions 2 and 3) you have answered **by circling the relevant numbers on the front page** of the examination paper provided.
- **Question 2 in Section B:** Question 2.1 is a 19-mark question based on theory. No application to the case study is required in question 2.1. Question 2.2 (6 marks) is a case study question.
- **Question 3 in Section B:** Question 3.1 (a 19-mark question) is based on theory (no application to the case study is required). Question 3.2 (6 marks) is based on the case study.
- **No calculations** are expected, except the calculation in the *weighted average method* in chapter 5.
- Remember, that if you leave empty spaces, I cannot award you marks.
- Do not be scared of the case study questions. You have had ample exercise and examples of typical case study questions.
- **Study ALL the chapters referred to in the study material.** ALL sections are important.
- **Study well in advance.** Students tend to underestimate the module content.
