NovoBooks.com

NovoBooks com is an online book store, established in 2014. They offer over two million books across categories such as history, literature, cooking and children's books. In addition to physical books being delivered, the company also makes available e-books from a wide variety of international and local publishers, accessible to readers anytime (online or offline) and anywhere via a smartphone, computer, tablet or any other electronic reading device.

NovoBooks decided to operate online because it enables them to offer a fulltime (24/7) service, save on operational costs, serve customers across the country and create a global community. In 2015, the company recognised the shift in consumer behaviour in respect of mobile usage and therefore set itself a goal to increase visibility of its website on mobile devices. The aim was to improve conversion and increase NovoBooks mobile site's performance on search engine result pages (SERPs) using Google AdWords. With this strategy, NovoBooks' mobile search traffic had risen to 20%, compared to 14% in respect of desktop and tablet search traffic. The company is currently building social media links to its website and aims to do more in order to achieve online marketing success.
